

## **Call for Nominations Editor-In-Chief ACM Transactions on Reconfigurable Technology and Systems**

The term of the current Editor-in-Chief (EiC) of the [ACM Transactions on Reconfigurable Technology and Systems](#) (TRETS) is coming to an end, and the [ACM](#) Publications Board has set up a nominating committee to assist the Board in selecting the next EiC. TRETS is the premier journal dedicated to the full range of FPGA and Reconfigurable Systems from technology up through design automation and systems including architecture and applications. TRETS was established in 2008 and has seen growing submissions, quality, and impact over the past decade. We expect the new EiC to lead the journal as the role and technology for journals evolve and to continue to enhance the visibility, quality, and impact of the journal in light of the changing roles for reconfigurable technology and accelerators.

Nominations, including self nominations, are invited for a three-year term as TRETS EiC, beginning on March 1, 2019. The EiC appointment may be renewed at most one time. This is an entirely voluntary position, but ACM will provide appropriate administrative support.

Appointed by the ACM Publications Board, Editors-in-Chief (EiCs) of ACM journals are delegated full responsibility for the editorial management of the journal consistent with the journal's charter and general ACM policies. The Board relies on EiCs to ensure that the content of the journal is of high quality and that the editorial review process is both timely and fair. He/she has final say on acceptance of papers, size of the Editorial Board, and appointment of Associate Editors. Self-nominations are encouraged, and should include a statement of the candidate's vision for the future development of TRETS. The deadline for submitting nominations is October 15, 2018, although nominations will continue to be accepted until the position is filled.
